Performs horizontal integration planning, and interfaces with other functional areas, as well as across the projects. Ensures technical solutions and schedules are implemented in a timely manner. Responsible for formulating and enforcing work standards, defining schedules, reviewing work discrepancies, and communicating policies, purposes, and goals of the Program. Responsible for coordination with the customer in the formulation of project integration planning and execution activities. Represent and support the customer in various project venues and control gates.
